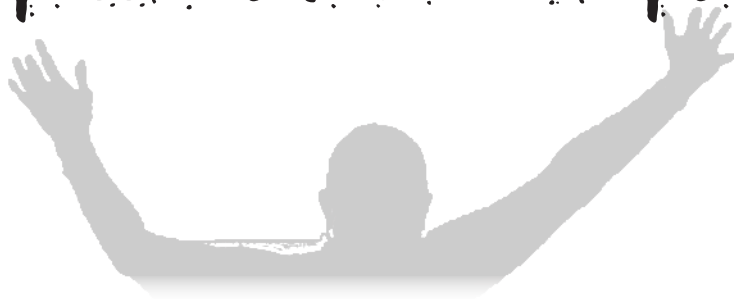




Methodists Living Marriage Equality
